MEET THE CAST

Mr. Saunders - Cary Kann - This is Cary's second time impersonating the excitable and determined Henry Saunders. Each of the shows with which he has been involved have been special, a place to meet new talented people from around the area and always a welcome reunion with those who have returned again to entertain and delight our audiences. 
